REDUNDANCY

Whilst we at **UNISON**Wakefield District Branch understand the temptation of accessing your pension early and receiving a lump sum of cash, all for the small price of taking Voluntary Redundancy. We urge all members to consider what this really means:

Selling your job!

Voluntary redundancy is a back door way of making job cuts and cuts to services. Whilst we do not know the precise figures, UNISON estimates between 400 and 500 jobs will be sold, and once voluntary redundancy is agreed, the job must be deleted. This will result in substantial increases in workload for the colleagues you leave behind, with no additional support or pay. This will lead to a decline in the services that the council provide and could potentially result in the outsourcing of any "underperforming" service.

NJC Pay Offer

The votes are in, and although 75% voted to reject the pay offer, we only achieved a turnout of 31% and therefore **UNISON** has now agreed on the £1,290 pay offer. This should be in council worker's November pay packet, along with backpay. We want to know why only 31% of our members voted, so please get in touch with us and let the branch know what we can do better to engage with you. We have been informed that Unite have been telling workers that they will be reballoting workplaces on the NJC pay offer. The only place this is happening in Yorkshire is at Leeds City Council, for Red Book Workers alone! They, like **UNISON**. did not meet the turnout threshold in WMDC.

Workplace Violence

Having seen that **UNISON** put out a survey, the council have now decided to implement a working group to tackle violence in schools. Whilst this has been brought about because of the work **UNISON** has done, this is a council led group, and we would urge anyone who has...



... been affected by this issue to please get in contact with the branch so we can support **you**.

95% of respondents told us that they have experienced verbal and/or physical violence in the workplace in the last 12 months. This is absolutely unacceptable and we at the branch are continuing to work with the council and schools to ensure **you** are safe at work!


